- 1. Welcome, Roll Call, and approval of July 31st Minutes—Dr. Burns (5 min)
 - a. There was a motion and a second; the minutes were approved.

 - a. Test Trends and Hot Topics—Dr. Shone (5 min)



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- i. Dr. Shone discussed at a high level the recent test trends and noted partners stating reduced demand on testing. Discussion followed.
- b. **Developing Collateral Materials for the Testing Matrix**—Dr. Burns (5 min)
 - i. Dr. Burns asked the group what type of collateral materials are needed to be developed for the Testing Matrix. Suggestions included hospital and lab C-Suite, county managers, doctors, employers, possibly the general population (should be readable for non-scientists and non-clinicians)
- c. Laboratory Data Questionnaire—Hayley Young (5 min)
 - i. The team is working to further develop a data strategy and ways to better streamline data collection and reporting. Have developed a short list of questions that were sent out with the meeting materials and asking for labs to provide responses to those questions.
- d. Commercial Lab Pooling Strategy Discussion—Dr. Datto (15 min)
 - Discussion around real time experience/perspective from large commercial labs that have put forward pooling strategies to EUA if there are lessons learned, context for pooling, etc.
- e. *Respiratory Pathogen Surveillance and COVID Testing*—Dr. Shone (15 min)
 - i. This discussion was started, but it will lead to workgroups mid-week next week. The group needs to develop a strategy and guidance.
- f. Scientific Council Review Needs—Dr. Datto (5 min)
 - i. The state needs to create guidance/review around the following:
 - 1. Saliva Testing
 - 2. Antigen Guidance
 - a. NC made news partnered with 6 other states on procuring 500,000 antigen tests for the state. We need to develop a strategy for use and deployment of these.
 - 3. Newly approved tests (e.g., Helix and Next Gen Sequencing)
