3 Actions Businesses Can Take to Help Slow the Spread

- 1 Follow the guidance for your business.
- Be a role model and *Get Behind the Mask* and the 3Ws. Post flyers, amplify on social media, and share videos.
- Use SlowCOVIDNC, North Carolina's exposure notification app. Encourage employees and customers to download and use the SlowCOVIDNC mobile app.

- Get tested if they have symptoms of COVID-19 or think they have been exposed to COVID-19.

 You can also share the flyers as graphics on your business social media account(s).



Use SlowCOVIDNC, North Carolina's exposure notification app.

 Encourage your employees and customers to download and use <u>SlowCOVIDNC</u> with <u>this flyer option 1</u> and <u>flyer option 2</u>. The anonymous exposure notification application for your smart phone can alert you if you have recently come into contact with another SlowCOVIDNC user who has tested positive.

Encourage your employees, customers and community to participate in contact tracing.

Contact tracing is an important way to reach out to people who have been near someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Everyone can be part of the solution by answering the call when the COVID-19 Community Team reaches out for contact tracing.

- Get the Word Out with Contact Tracing Social Media Graphics
 - Answer the Call. Encourage your employees, customers and community to answer the phone if a member of the COVID-19 Community Team or Local Health Department reaches out by promoting these social media graphics.

Help is available!

 If people are asked to quarantine due to COVID-19, there is <u>support</u>. Let your employees and community members know that they can get the support they need with this <u>poster</u> and <u>brochure</u>.

Get the Word Out with Social Media Graphics

 Help your employees and community members know that no-cost supports may be available for eligible people who test positive or are exposed to COVID-19 by sharing these <u>graphics and posts</u> on your social accounts.
