# How to Find a Spot to Take Your Shot



**COVID-19 vaccines are available in North Carolina for everyone ages 12 and up. Find your spot to take your shot!**

- **Find a vaccine provider.** Use the Find A Vaccine Location tool at [MySpot.nc.gov](https://MySpot.nc.gov). Enter your zip code or the name of your town or city to find vaccine providers near you.
- **Schedule your appointment.** You will likely need an appointment to get vaccinated. There are several ways to schedule an appointment using [MySpot.nc.gov](https://MySpot.nc.gov):
  1. Click on the provider's website and follow their instructions on how to schedule an appointment online;
  2. Call the phone number listed for the provider;
  3. Or click the blue "Schedule Now" button if displayed under a provider's name. You will receive a text or email confirming your appointment.
- **Be patient.** You may have to wait until more appointments open to schedule a time to get your vaccine.
- **Get help with transportation if you need it.** You can find your local transit agency online. Call the phone number listed for assistance.
